Windows 7 Development Using Managed Code (by Ioannis Stavrinides)

This session will introduce WPF and the Windows API Code Pack for Microsoft .NET Framework using Visual Studio 2010. Among other, we will cover the exciting features of WPF. Also, many live demos will be performed showing how developers can build Jump Lists, Progress Bars, Tabbed Thumbnails and Tabbed Toolbars as well as how they can make use of the Icon Overlay feature.

SQL Server 2008 R2: Features for Developers and IT Pros (by Artemakis Artemiou)

This session will introduce the key features of SQL Server 2008 R2 for Developers and IT Pros. We will talk about the manageability enhancements in SQL Server Database Engine, Connectivity to SQL Azure, Data-tier Application Upgrade, SQL Server Utility, Master Data Services, StreamInsight, enhancements in Reporting Services and much more! Many live demos will be performed showing the audience how they can be more productive with even less effort!
